Modern fencing originated in the 18th century, influenced by the Italian school of fencing of the Renaissance as modified by the French school. The squadron was reactivated in 1953 as part of the expansion on air defenses and served in this role from bases in New York until 1958, when it moved to Texas. In Texas it assumed the additional mission of combat crew training for Lockheed F-104 Starfighter pilots.

In his training manual of Feng Shou Chee Soo details several areas of technique such as for Feng Shou (拳) is a 20th-century Martial Arts style as taught by Chee Soo, a Barnardo's orphan and soldier originally named Clifford Soo, who grew up in London. According to Chee Soo, Feng Shou originated in the 1930s when Chan Kam Lee, an importer and exporter of precious stones, taught a class in Red Lion Square in Holborn, though there are no verified records of the existence of Lee, or the martial arts class. relaxed and generally involved circular motion with no blocking.
