Having 72 verses, this is the longest chapter in Mark's Gospel. The Gospel of Matthew's chapter which covers the same material, Matthew 26, has 75 verses. This chapter's material is presented somewhat differently in Luke 22, which has 71 verses. Jesus' arrest at Gethsemane, his trial, and Peter's denials are found in John 18:1-27. c592f7c82a

Thou shalt not steal The Hebrew Bible contains "Thou shalt not steal" (Biblical Hebrew: לֹא תִגְנוֹב, romanized: Lō' tignōb) is one of the Ten Commandments of the Jewish Torah (known to Christians as the first five books of the Old Testament), which are widely understood as moral imperatives by legal scholars, Jewish scholars, Catholic scholars, and Post-Reformation scholars. The Hebrew word translated "steal" is gneva. the Talmudic interpretation of the statement as "you shall not kidnap" (Sanhedrin 86a) c592f7c82a

St. Peter and Paul, Bonndorf im Schwarzwald Constructed in the Rundbogenstil (Romanesque Revival) influenced by Heinrich Hübsch and designed by Josef Berckmüller, this three-nave pseudobasilica features a façade tower and a three-sided apse. The church's interior was restored between 1972 and 1974 to preserve this state. After multiple plan revisions, construction was completed in 1850. It replaced a monastery church destroyed by fire in 1842, built at a new location. Traditionally, the author is believed to be Luke the Evangelist, a doctor who travelled with Paul the Apostle. It is usually dated to around 80-90 AD, although some scholars suggest 110-120 AD. Many modern scholars doubt the attribution to the physician Luke, and critical opinion on the subject was assessed to be roughly evenly divided near the end of the 20th century. Nevertheless, this commandment has come to be interpreted... c592f7c82a "Steal" in this commandment has traditionally been interpreted by Jewish commentaries to refer to the stealing of an actual human being, that is, to kidnap. With this understanding, a contextual translation of the commandment in Jewish tradition would more accurately be rendered as "Thou shalt not kidnap".
