In 2019 China is estimated to have emitted 27% of world GHG, followed by the United States with 11%, then India with 6. In total the United States has emitted a quarter of world GHG, more than any other country. Annual emissions are over 15 tons per person and, amongst the top eight emitters, is the highest country by greenhouse gas emissions per person

The largest annual emissions are from China followed by the United States. When measuring production-based emissions, China emitted over 12.6 gigatonnes (Gt) CO₂eq of greenhouse gases in 2023, 35% of the world total. When measuring in consumption-based terms, which adds emissions associated with imported goods and extracts those associated with exported goods, China accounted for 13 gigatonnes (Gt) or 25% of global emissions in 2019. 5cda1f918d

Emissions trading The concept is also known as cap and trade (CAT) or emissions trading scheme (ETS). Emissions trading is a market-oriented approach to controlling pollution by providing economic incentives for reducing the emissions of pollutants. Other schemes include sulfur dioxide and other pollutants. One prominent example is carbon emission trading for CO₂ and other greenhouse gases which is a tool for climate change mitigation.
