Red Line (MBTA) The line runs south and east underground from Alewife station in North Cambridge through Somerville and Cambridge, surfacing to cross the Longfellow Bridge then returning to tunnels under Downtown Boston. The 1947 revision recommended an extension north to The Red Line is a rapid transit line operated by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) as part of the MBTA subway system. The Braintree branch runs southeast through Quincy and Braintree to Braintree station.
