Tragedy of the commons The concept has been widely discussed, and criticised, in economics, ecology and other sciences. In some situations, locals implement (often complex) social The tragedy of the commons is the concept that, if many people enjoy unfettered access to a finite, valuable resource, such as a pasture, they will tend to overuse it and may end up destroying its value altogether. Articulating solutions to the tragedy of the commons is one of the main problems of political philosophy. Even if some users exercised voluntary restraint, the other users would merely replace them, the predictable result being a "tragedy" for all 5316322c40

Mathematical economics (formulaic) solution. Proponents of this

approach claim that it allows the formulation of theoretical relationships with rigor, generality, and simplicity. Many others may be sufficiently complex to require numerical methods of solution, aided by software. Often, these applied methods are beyond simple geometry, and may include differential and integral calculus, difference and differential equations, matrix algebra, mathematical programming, or other computational methods. Still others are complex but tractable. Mathematical economics is the application of mathematical methods to represent theories and analyze problems in economics.

**NATO Submarine Rescue System** The system provides a rescue capability primarily to the partner nations of France, Norway and the United Kingdom, but also to NATO and allied nations and to any submarine equipped with a suitable mating surface around its hatches. Delivery of the complete system was achieved by October 2007. a self-contained breathing system developed by Divex (now part of James Fisher Defence). The NATO Submarine Rescue System (NSRS) is a tri-national project to develop an international submarine rescue system.
