Divisional insignia of the British Army The sign could be based on many things, geometry. Reintroduced officially in late 1940 in the Second World War, divisional formation signs were much more prevalent on uniforms and were taken up by many other formations, independent brigades, corps, armies, overseas and home commands, military districts and lines of communication areas. They were used on vehicles, sign posts and notice boards and were increasingly, but not universally, worn on uniform as the War progressed. They were intended (initially) as a security measure to avoid displaying the division's designation in the clear. territorial) were sent to India to relieve the regular army there and did not adopt division insignia, as did numbers of second line territorial and home Formation signs at the division level were first introduced in the British Army in the First World War. The collar insignia of the The sergeant major of the Army (SMA) is a unique noncommissioned rank and position of office in the United States Army. The SMA is appointed to serve as a spokesman to address the issues of enlisted soldiers to all officers, from warrant officers and lieutenants to the Army's highest positions. the Army, like counterparts in the other branches, wears a unique rank insignia, including a unique collar insignia ("brass"). The holder of this rank and position is the most senior enlisted soldier in the Army, unless an enlisted soldier is serving as the senior enlisted advisor to the chairman 5a4457ab05

These ranks and insignia were specific to the Heer and in special cases to senior Wehrmacht officers in the independent services; the uniforms and rank systems of the other branches of the Wehrmacht, the Luftwaffe (Air Force) and Kriegsmarine (Navy), were different, as were those of the SS which was a Party organization outside the Wehrmacht. The Nazi Party also had its own series of paramilitary uniforms and insignia. 5a4457ab05
