It is particularly useful when researchers want to understand the meaning that people attach to their experiences or when they want to uncover the underlying reasons for people's behavior. This type of research typically involves in-depth interviews, focus groups, or field observations in order to collect data that is rich in detail and context. Qualitative methods include ethnography, grounded theory, discourse. Qualitative research is often used to explore complex phenomena or to gain insight into people's experiences and perspectives on a particular topic 410113f6bb

Action research In his 1946 paper "Action Research and Minority Problems" he described action research as "a comparative research on the conditions and effects of various forms of social action and research leading to social action" that uses "a spiral of steps, each of which is composed of a circle of planning, action and fact-finding about the result of the action". Kurt Lewin, then a professor at MIT, first coined the term "action research" in 1944. research development, many methods have evolved that adjust the balance to focus more

Scientific inquiry includes creating a testable hypothesis through inductive reasoning, testing it through experiments and statistical analysis, and adjusting or discarding the hypothesis based on the results 410113f6bb
