experiments Take place in labs or specialized settings ► Field
experiments Take place in real world settings (schools,
businesses, neighborhoods) → substantial time, organization
Survey experiments Take place in survey Split-ballot: Different
respondents receive different survey versions More than simply
collecting experimental data by survey Describe a randomized

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experiment suitable for each kind of setting

Limited generalizability of randomized experiments Limited settings Geographic limitations Limitations in time Volunteers Volunteers in an experiment may differ from what random sampling would provide Perhaps in ways relevant to the outcome of the study Results may not generalize to any known population

Steps in designing an RCT experiments (cont) Treatment in randomized experiments may be unlike full-scale implementation in real world Experimental programs often have more motivated staff, better funding, etc. Long-run effects, incorporating others' reactions may also differ Example: Mandatory arrest for domestic violence may change victims' reporting behavior in the long- run, after they learn about

Enrollment Factors Probe Interactions Basic randomized experiments look at effect of just one treatment Factors look at interactions of multiple treatments Made-up example: Housing Vouchers Help Finding Housing in Low Poverty Neighborhoods → 4 arms Results show separate effects of vouchers of help finding housing, and combined effect interaction
