

Aristotle Introductory Readings

The treatise presents the art of dialectic - the invention and discovery of arguments in which the propositions rest upon commonly held opinions or endoxa (ἐνδοξα in Greek). Τοποὶ (τόποι) are "places" from which such arguments can be discovered or invented. eb5e14bab9

Little is known about Aristotle's life. He was born in the city of Stagira in northern Greece during the Classical period. His father, Nicomachus, died when Aristotle was a child, and he was brought up by a guardian. At around eighteen years old, he joined Plato's Academy in Athens and remained there until the age of thirty seven... eb5e14bab9 Originally from 's-Heerenberg (Monte Domini), he went to the University of Cologne in 1450, where he was taught by his uncle Gerhardus de Monte, and received his Master of Arts in 1454, holding an arts professorship there from 1455 until 1473, when he became a doctor of theology. He then taught in the faculty of theology until his death. eb5e14bab9

Aristotle first lists out The Topics (Ancient Greek: Τοπικά; Latin: Topica) is the name given to one of Aristotle's six works on logic collectively known as the Organon. Book I is introductory, laying down a number of preliminary principles upon which dialectical argumentation proceeds eb5e14bab9

Aristotelian ethics Aristotle first used the term ethics to name a field of study developed by his predecessors Socrates and Plato which is devoted to the attempt to provide Aristotle first used the term ethics to name a field of study developed by his predecessors Socrates and Plato which is devoted to the attempt to provide a rational response to the question of how humans should best live. Aristotle regarded ethics and politics as two related but separate fields of study, since ethics examines the good of the individual, while politics examines the good of the city-state, which he considered to be the best type of community eb5e14bab9

He wrote several Thomist commentaries on Aristotle, including the *Physics*, *De anima*, and the *logica nova*, most of which were printed in Cologne during his lifetime or shortly thereafter. He was a defender of the Thomistic interpretation of Aristotle against that of Albert the Great and his followers... eb5e14bab9

Simplicius of Cilicia Although his writings are all commentaries on Aristotle and other authors, rather than original compositions, his intelligent and prodigious learning makes him the last great philosopher of pagan antiquity. 540) was

a disciple of Ammonius Hermiae and Damascius, and was one of the last of the Neoplatonists. He was among the pagan philosophers persecuted by Justinian in the early 6th century, and was forced for a time to seek refuge in the Persian court, before being allowed back into the empire. 480 – c. 529. His works have preserved much information about earlier philosophers which would have otherwise been lost. He wrote extensively on the works of Aristotle's predecessors, he then proceeds through a two standard introductory schemes on the philosophy of Aristotle and on the categories itself, and continues through Simplicius of Cilicia (; Greek: Συμπλίκιος ὁ Κίλιξ; c. 490–540). eb5e14bab9

At the end of the Nicomachean Ethics, Aristotle declared that the inquiry into ethics leads into a discussion of politics. The two works are frequently considered to be parts of a larger treatise – or perhaps connected lectures – dealing with the "philosophy of human affairs". In Aristotle's hierarchical system of philosophy he considers politics, the study of communities, to be of higher priority than ethics, which concerns individuals. eb5e14bab9

Aristotle As the founder of the Peripatetic school of philosophy in the Lyceum in Athens, he began the wider Aristotelian tradition that followed, which set the groundwork for the development of modern science. Aristotle's writings have been read more or less continuously since ancient times, and his ethical treatises in particular continue to influence philosophers working today. Aristotle emphasized the practical importance of developing excellence (virtue) of character (Greek êthikê aretê), as the way to achieve what is finally more important... eb5e14bab9

scholastic and Thomist. he argued for Aristotle's salvation against the scholarly consensus that Aristotle was in Hell eb5e14bab9

Diodorus Cronus 284 BC) was a Greek philosopher and dialectician connected to the Megarian school.
