Natural History (Pliny) addition to life, for as he states in the preface, Vita vigilia est, “to be alive is to be watchful”; in a military metaphor of a sentry keeping watch in The Natural History (Latin: Naturalis historia) is a Latin work by Pliny the Elder. It is the only work by Pliny to have survived, and the last that he published. Despite the work's title, its subject area is not limited to what is today understood by natural history; Pliny himself defines his scope as "the natural world, or life". The rest was published posthumously by Pliny's nephew, Pliny. He published the first 10 books in AD 77, but had not made a final revision of the remainder at the time of his death during the AD 79 eruption of Vesuvius. It is encyclopedic in scope, but its structure is not like that of a modern encyclopedia. The largest single work to have survived from the Roman Empire to the modern day, the Natural History compiles information gleaned from other ancient authors

History of education The earliest known formal school was developed in Egypt's Middle Kingdom under the direction of Kheti, treasurer to Mentuhotep II (2061–2010 BC). In ancient India, education was mainly imparted through the Vedic and Buddhist learning system, while the first education system in ancient China was created in Xia dynasty (2076–1600 BC). Historical studies have included virtually every nation. For example, in Athens, during the 5th and 4th century BC, aside from two years military training, the state played little part in schooling. The first schools in Ancient Rome arose by poets, and priests who kept the oral histories of the Incas alive by imparting the knowledge of their culture, history, customs, and traditions throughout The history of education, like other history, extends at least as far back as the first written records recovered from ancient civilizations. In the city-states of ancient Greece, most education was private, except in Sparta

2008 NRL season The premiership was won by the Manly Warringah Sea Eagles who set the record for the biggest grand final winning margin (40-0) in Australia's rugby league history.
