The Quantitative Reasoning section The Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT (JEE-mat))) is a computer adaptive test (CAT) intended to assess certain analytical, quantitative, verbal, and data literacy skills for use in admission to a graduate management program, such as a Master of Business Administration (MBA) program. The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) owns and operates the test, and states that the GMAT assesses critical thinking and problem-solving abilities while also addressing data analysis skills that it believes to be vital to real-world business and management success. It can be taken up to five times a year but no more than eight times total. Answering the test questions requires reading comprehension, and mathematical skills such as arithmetic, and algebra. giving test takers the ability to review all answers at the end of each section and edit up to three answers per section 5ef7cd9d9c
