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The R5 was marketed in the United States and Canada as Le Car, from 1976 until 1983. Renault Scénic The first generation was based on the chassis of the Mégane, a small family car. It was relaunched in 2024 as a fully electric vehicle called the Renault Scénic E-Tech which is the production version of the Renault Scénic Vision concept unveiled in 2022, with the production version to be unveiled at the 2023 Munich Motor Show. The second, third and fourth generations The Renault Scénic (French pronunciation: [senik]), also spelled without the acute accent as Scenic, especially in languages other than French, is a car which was produced by French car manufacturer Renault, the first to be labelled as a small multi-purpose vehicle (MPV) in Europe. In May 2022 Renault announced it was discontinuing the standard Scénic with the Grand Scénic following shortly after. added a four-wheel drive model called the Renault Scénic RX4, which was discontinued by the arrival of the Scénic II. It was introduced in late 1999, under the Clio Symbol name, as the derivative version of the second generation Renault Clio, and unlike the hatchback it was marketed only in those countries where saloons were traditionally preferred over hatchbacks, while it was not sold in Western Europe. The first-generation Twingo (two door, front engine) debuted at the Paris Motor Show on 5 October 1992, receiving its formal market launch in continental European markets beginning in April 1993. rear engine) debuted at the 2014 Geneva Motor Show, receiving its formal market launch in September 2014.
