It is Disney's largest business segment by employee headcount, with approximately 130,000 of the company's 180,000 employees as of 2015. In March 2018, Disney Consumer Products and Interactive Media was merged into Parks and Resorts and renamed Disney Parks, Experiences and Products. In September 2020, Disney Parks, Experiences and Products laid off 28,000 employees in wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. 10c1681647 DCP's origins trace back to 1929, when Walt Disney licensed the image of Mickey Mouse for use on children's books. However, following Walt Disney's death in 1966, the company's profits, especially in the animation sector, began to decline.
