O Heiland, reiß die Himmel auf "O Heiland, reiß die Himmel auf" was first published in Würzburg in the collection Das Allerschönste Kind in der Welt (The most beautiful "O Heiland, reiß die Himmel auf" (O Saviour, tear open the heavens) is a Christian Advent song. The text was first printed in 1622, attributed to Friedrich Spee; the melody was first printed in 1666. printed in 1666

Rüdiger von der Goltz 2: "Der Gustav Adolf Joachim Rüdiger Graf von der Goltz (8 December 1865 – 4 November 1946) was a German army general during the First World War. Goltz stayed with his troops in Finland until December 1918 representing German interests, and in practice ruled the country as a military dictator during this period. After the Armistice of 11 November 1918, Goltz commanded the army of the local German-established government of Latvia, which in 1919 was instrumental in the defeat of the Russian Bolsheviks and their local allies in Latvia. He commanded the Baltic Sea Division, which successfully intervened in the Finnish Civil War in the spring of 1918. The troops commanded by Goltz suffered a defeat against Estonia in 1919 and were eventually unsuccessful in retaining German control over Latvia and Estonia.
