Earthquake-resistant structures According to building codes, earthquake-resistant structures are intended to withstand the largest earthquake of a certain probability that is likely to occur at their location. earthquake engineering is to erect structures that fare better during seismic activity than their conventional counterparts. This means the loss of life should be minimized by preventing collapse of the buildings for rare earthquakes while the loss of the functionality should be limited for more frequent ones.
