The suit also provides protection against hypothermia and (since the Mk 10 version) has replaced the Steinke hood rescue device. It was designed by British company RFD Beaufort Limited and allows submariners to escape from a sunken submarine. The suit allows survivors to escape a disabled submarine at depths down to 600 feet (183 m), with an ascent speed of 2–3 meters/second, at a rate of eight or more sailors per hour. Protective clothing is applied to traditional categories of clothing, and protective gear applies to items such as pads, guards, shields, or masks, and others. This concept is taught to managers in industry, to be promoted as standard practice in the workplace. It has also been used to inform public policy, in fields such as road safety. It is a widely accepted system promoted by numerous safety organizations. Various illustrations are used to depict this system, most commonly a triangle 9c3465e9d6
