A set of guidelines and controls, published by the Centers of Diseases Control and Prevention (cdc) that requires the employer and the employee to assume that all human blood and specified human body fluids are infectious for HIV, HBV and other blood borne pathogens. An efficacy standard on a product label tells you which bacteria will be effectively destroyed by the product being used. 8a8cb15f90 Fungi 8a8cb15f90 Name and describe the three types of nerves found in the body. - Sensory nerves: carry impulses or messages from the sense organs to the brain, where sensations such as touch, cold, experienced; called receptors and are located at the surface of the skin. - Motor Nerves: carry impulses from the brain to the muscles 8a8cb15f90 List and describe the functions of the five types of tissue found in the human body. Connective tissue : supports, protects, and binds together other tissues of the body, examples are bone, cartilage, ligament, tendon, fascia which separate muscles and fat or adipose tissue. - Epithelial tissue protective covering on body surface such as the skin, mucous membranes, linings of the heart, digestive and respiratory organs and glands Liquid tissue carries food, waste products and hormones by means of the blood and lymph. - Muscular tissue: Contracts and moves various parts of the body. -Nerve tissue: Carries messages to and from the brain, and controls and coordinates all body functions. 8a8cb15f90 What are atoms? Atoms are the structural units of the elements that make up all matter. An atom is the smallest particle of an element that retains the properties of that element. 8a8cb15f90 What is decontamination ? Explain the three levels of decontamination -Decontamination is the removal of pathogens and other substances from tools and surfaces. The three levels are: • Sterilization, High level, completely destroy every organism on a surface, usually by the use of an Autoclave. • Disinfection, second level does not kill bacterial spores but controls microorganism on hard nonporous surfaces such as cuticle nippers/extracting tools and other salon implements. By the use of an approved disinfectant.
