This Is Our Music (Ornette Coleman album) It was Coleman's first album with drummer Ed Blackwell (replacing Billy Higgins), and his only album on Atlantic to include a standard, in this case a version of "Embraceable You" by George and Ira Gershwin. improvisation is not new. In early jazz, that kind of group playing was known as Dixieland. Don Cherry (trumpeter) Beginning in the late 1950s, he had a long tenure performing in the bands of saxophonist Ornette Coleman, including on the pioneering free jazz albums *The Shape of Jazz to Come* (1959) and *Free Jazz: A Collective Improvisation* (1961). Cherry also collaborated separately with musicians including John Coltrane, Charlie Haden, Sun Ra, Ed Blackwell, the New York Contemporary Five, and Albert Ayler. including on the pioneering free jazz albums *The Shape of Jazz to Come* (1959) and *Free Jazz: A Collective Improvisation* (1961). Cherry also collaborated Donald Eugene Cherry (November 18, 1936 – October 19, 1995) was an American jazz trumpeter, bandleader, and multi-instrumentalist
