The Dhamma Society The Sixth Buddhist Council (Pali: චෛත්ත සංග්ගායනා (Chaṭṭha Saṅgāyana); Burmese: ခုနစ်ဆယ့်ငါးသင်္ဂဟ; Sinhala: චෛත්ත සංග්ගායනා) was a general council of Theravāda Buddhism, held in a specially built Mahā Pāsāṇa Guhā (Great Cave) and pagoda complex at Kaba Aye Pagoda in Yangon, Burma. The Council lasted from Vesak (Visākha) 1954 to Vesak 1956, its completion coinciding with the traditional 2500th anniversary of the Gautama Buddha's Parinibbāna. The council was attended by 2500 monastics from eight Theravādin Buddhist countries.
