Raymond Carver (May 25, 1938 – August 2, 1988) was an American short story writer and poet. In their 1989 nomination of Carver for the Pulitzer Prize for Fiction, the jury concluded, "The revival in recent years of the short story is attributable in great measure to Carver's mastery of the form. The definitive collection of his stories, *Where I'm Calling From*, was published shortly before his death in 1988. His breakout collection, *What We Talk About When We Talk About Love* (1981), received immediate acclaim and established Carver as an important figure in the literary world. (May 25, 1938 – August 2, 1988) was an American short story writer and poet. He published his first collection of stories, *Will Raymond Clevie Carver Jr.* It was followed by *Cathedral*

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Carver was born in Weymouth, Province of Massachusetts Bay, on April 13, 1710, the son of David and Hannah (Dyer) Carver. His father was modestly wealthy and was elected to various public positions in Weymouth and Canterbury. The family moved to Canterbury, Connecticut, when Carver was still a young child. The details of his education are unknown but he was literate, taught himself surveying and cartography, and may have...
