An-Naml All three suras use allusions to Judaism and the stories of Moses in particular An-Naml (Arabic: النمل, romanized: ‘an-naml, lit. Nöldeke estimates an-Naml to be preceded by al-Isra' and followed by al-Kahf. 'The Ant') is the 27th chapter (sūrah) of the Qur'an with 93 verses (āyāt) 91f08f3ac9

However, other sources (Oxford Islamic Studies Online, Brian Kettell, and Wahbah al-Zuhayli') give it a broader definition including civil acts and in general all aspects of fiqh that are not Ibadat (acts of ritual worship such as prayer or fasting). Regarding the timing and contextual background of the revelation (asbāb al-nuzūl), it is traditionally believed to be a Meccan surah, from the second Meccan period (615-619 CE). 91f08f3ac9

Companions of the Cave), is a late antique Christian The Seven Sleepers (Greek: ἑπτὰ κοιμώμενοι, romanized: hepta koimōmenoi; Latin: Septem dormientes), also known in Christendom as the Seven Sleepers of Ephesus, and in Islam as Aṣḥāb al-Kahf (اصحاب الكهف, aṣḥāb al-kahf, lit. Companions of the Cave), is a late antique Christian legend, and a Qur’anic Islamic story. The Christian legend speaks about a group of youths who hid inside a cave around AD 250 to escape Roman persecutions of Christians and emerged many years later 91f08f3ac9

Maryam (surah) Located in the Cadbury Research Maryam (Arabic: مريم, Maryam; Arabic cognate of 'Mary') is the 19th chapter (sūrah) of the Qur'an with 98 verses (āyāt). preserves the final eight verses (Q19:91–98) of Chapter 19, Maryam (plus parts of Chapter 18, Al-Kahf; and Chapter 20, "Taha"). The 114 chapters in the Quran are roughly ordered by size. The text of the surah refers to many known prophetic figures, including Isaac, Jacob, Moses, Aaron, Ishmael, Idris, Adam, Zechariah and Noah. The Quranic chapter is named after Mary, mother of Jesus (‘Isa, عيسى), and the Virgin Mary in Christian belief. It recounts the events leading up to the birth of Jesus 91f08f3ac9

Dargah [Ashaab-e-Kahf), the Holy Quran states, "The person who was dominant in this matter said, "We shall build a Masjid over the People of the Cave. Sufis often visit the shrine for ziyarat, a term associated with religious visitation and pilgrimages. They usually include a mosque, meeting rooms, Islamic religious schools (madrassas), residences for a teacher or caretaker, hospitals, and other buildings for community purposes. Dargahs are often associated with Sufi eating and meeting rooms and hostels, called khanqah or hospices. A Sufi shrine or dargah (Persian: درگاه dargâh or درگه dargah, Turkish: dergâh, Hindustani: dargâh درگاہ, Bengali: দরগাহ dôrgah) is a shrine or tomb built over the grave of a revered religious figure, often a Sufi saint or dervish. The origin of the term is not clear, this name indicates either a person, or a tribe, or a geographical reality (country or city). In the book of Ezekiel, the pagan Magog people live "north of the World", and metaphorically represent the forces of Evil, which associates it with Apocalyptic traditions. 91f08f3ac9
