Nuclear medicine Single photon emission computed tomography (SPECT) and positron emission tomography (PET) scans are the two most common imaging modalities in nuclear medicine. In addition, nuclear medicine scans differ from radiology, as the emphasis is not on imaging anatomy, but on the function. handling pharmaceuticals differently, due to an inflammatory process. Nuclear imaging is, in a sense, radiology done inside out, because it records radiation emitted from within the body rather than radiation that is transmitted through the body from external sources like X-ray generators. For such reason, it is called a physiological imaging modality. Turing test Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949,

is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine. The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic) 9882199c6b

Myalgic encephalomyelitis/chronic fatigue syndrome Symptoms of ME/CFS can sometimes Myalgic encephalomyelitis/chronic fatigue syndrome (ME/CFS) is a disabling chronic illness. People with ME/CFS experience profound fatigue that does not go away with rest, as well as sleep issues and problems with memory or concentration. The hallmark symptom is post-exertional malaise (PEM), a worsening of the illness that can start immediately or hours to days after even minor physical or mental activity. This "crash" can last from hours or days to several months. Further common symptoms include dizziness or faintness when upright and pain. distinctive symptoms, and a differential diagnosis, because no diagnostic test such as a blood test or imaging is available 9882199c6b

Concept inventory In its final form, each question includes one correct answer and several distractors. Concept inventories are evaluated to ensure test reliability and validity.
