Sex comedy was popular in 17th century English Restoration theatre. From 1953 to 1965,

Hollywood released a number of sex comedies, some featuring stars such as Doris Day, Jack Lemmon and Marilyn Monroe. The United Kingdom released a spate of sex comedies in the 1970s, notably the Carry On series. Hollywood released Animal House in 1978, which was followed by a long line of teen sex comedies in the early 1980s, e.g. Porky's, Bachelor Party and Risky Business. Other countries with a significant sex comedy film production include Argentina (comedia picaresca), Brazil (pornoanchada), Italy (commedia sexy all'italiana) and Mexico (sexicomedias).

The category has undergone several name changes, mostly involving the addition or removal of the word comedy. This includes, in the late 70's, the unwieldy Outstanding Writing In A Comedy Or Comedy-Variety Or Music Series. The category name eventually found greater stability when, in 1982, it settled on Outstanding Writing for a Variety or Music Program. That name lasted almost two decades until 2000 when the word comedy was added. The current name dates from 2012. f6da966c39

The CCA have been held in different cities, most often in Toronto and London, Ontario. Between 2003 and 2015, the awards were held as part of the

Canadian Comedy Awards Festival, with showcase performances by nominees and other comedic talent. The Comedy Network broadcast the first two award ceremonies and several specials of festival performances. These broadcasts have earned two Gemini Award nominations. f6da966c39 The Comedy Awards represented Comedy Central's second attempt at creating an annual awards show. Comedy Central's first attempt, the Commie Awards, ran once in 2003. Comedy Central also hosted the American Comedy Awards in 2001, which was those awards' last successive year after having been founded in 1987. f6da966c39

They are run through a non-profit organization and volunteer committees, drawing membership from the Alliance of Canadian Cinema, Television and Radio Artists (ACTRA), the Canadian Actors' Equity Association (CAEA), the Directors Guild of Canada (DGC), the Writers Guild of Canada (WGC), and the Comedy Association. Some awards are determined by industry members while others are open to public voting. f6da966c39 == Antiquity == f6da966c39 Comedy originated in ancient Greece: in Athenian democracy, the public opinion of voters was influenced by political satire performed by comic poets in theaters. The theatrical genre of Greek comedy can be described as a dramatic performance pitting two groups, ages, genders, or societies against each other in an amusing agon or conflict. Northrop Frye depicted these two opposing sides as a "Society of Youth" and a "Society of the Old". A revised view characterizes the essential

agon of comedy as a struggle between a relatively powerless youth and the societal conventions posing obstacles to his hopes. In this struggle, the youth then becomes constrained by his lack of social authority, and is left with little choice but to resort to ruses which engender dramatic irony, which provokes laughter. f6da966c39

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
