Occupational exposure limit Statistical tools are available to assess An occupational exposure limit is an upper limit on the acceptable concentration of a hazardous substance in workplace air for a particular material or class of materials. In these cases, hazard banding or control banding strategies can be used to ensure safe handling. It is typically set by competent national authorities and enforced by legislation to protect occupational safety and health. These methods are available from OSHA Technical Manual and NIOSH Manual of Analytical Methods. There are many dangerous substances for which there are no formal occupational exposure limits. It is an important tool in risk assessment

and in the management of activities involving handling of dangerous substances. analytical methods 3cc40e1201

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
