The final generation was developed independently by Rover on the platform of its predecessor, and was available as a three or five-door hatchback. Furthermore, due to post-war steel shortage, and aluminium surplus, Land Rovers received non-rusting aluminium alloy bodies, favouring their longevity. Contrary to conventional car and truck chassis, it used a sturdier fully box-welded frame. Inspired by the World War II jeep, it was the first mass-produced civilian four-wheel drive car with doors, and an available hard roof. In 1992, Land Rover claimed that 70% of all the vehicles they had built were still in use 77c67482da

The first generation of vehicles produced under the Range Rover name, it was built as a two-door model for its first 11 years, until a four-door also became available in 1981.
