The examination papers are prepared by the board, but the scripts are marked by the schools concerned; and all other aspects of the admissions process are handled independently by each school. are assessed by written, oral and listening papers. They are set by the Independent Schools Examinations Board. Only Maths, English and a science are compulsory papers. Although some schools may require you to complete Common Entrance Examinations (commonly known as CE) are taken by independent school pupils in the UK as part of the selective admissions process at age 13, though ten independent schools do select at 11 using different test papers.
