These two forces are described in terms of electromagnetic fields. Relays were used extensively in telephone exchanges and early computers to perform logical operations. 1920177cb0 Crystal radios are the simplest type of radio receiver and can be made with a few inexpensive parts, such as a wire for an antenna, a coil of wire, a capacitor, a crystal detector, and earphones. However they are passive receivers, while other radios use an amplifier powered by current from a battery or wall outlet to make the radio signal louder.
