Prior to October 1, 1993, substance abuse was addressed by chapters 396 and 397. Chapter 396 was primarily concerned with alcoholism while chapter 397, was more concerned with drug dependency. As of October 1, 1993, the new chapter 397, called the Hal S. Marchman Alcohol and Other Drug Services Act, superseded chapters 396 and 397. Unlike the prior chapters the new chapter 397, dubbed the "Marchman Act", does not distinguish between drug dependency and alcoholism using the term "substance abuse." 1fd5447982

consequences, and actions which can mitigate these effects. The results of a risk assessment process may be expressed in a quantitative or qualitative fashion. e. Judgments "on the tolerability of the risk on the basis of a risk analysis" (i. risk evaluation) also form part of the process. Hazard analysis forms the first stage of a risk assessment process. The output from such a process may also be called a risk assessment 1fd5447982
