Cathodic protection AMPP cathodic protection certification has four levels: Tester, Technician, Technologist Cathodic protection (CP;) is a technique used to control the corrosion of a metal surface by making it the cathode of an electrochemical cell. The sacrificial metal then corrodes instead of the protected metal. For structures such as long pipelines, where passive galvanic cathodic protection is not adequate, an external DC electrical power source is used to provide sufficient current. A simple method of protection connects the metal to be protected to a more easily corroded "sacrificial metal" to act as the anode. methods, but two of them are more common: AMPP certification and ISO 15257 6b10789508
