Testing effect Pre-testing has The testing effect (also known as retrieval practice, active recall, practice testing, or test-enhanced learning) suggests long-term memory is increased when part of the learning period is devoted to retrieving information from memory. It is different from the more general practice effect, defined in the APA Dictionary of Psychology as "any change or improvement

Tests vary in style, rigor and requirements. There is no general consensus or invariable standard for test formats and difficulty. Animal testing The focus of animal testing varies on a continuum from pure research, focusing on developing fundamental knowledge of an organism, to applied research, which may focus on answering some questions of great practical importance, such as finding a cure for. In education, animal testing is sometimes a component of biology or psychology courses. Experimental research with animals is usually conducted in universities, medical schools, pharmaceutical companies, defense establishments, and commercial facilities that provide animal-testing services to the industry.

This approach can be contrasted with field studies in which animals are observed in their natural environments or habitats. and toxicology, including cosmetics testing. Intelligence quotient The resulting fraction (quotient) was multiplied by 100 to obtain the IQ score. Originally, IQ was a score obtained by dividing a person's estimated mental age, obtained by administering an intelligence test, by the person's chronological age. For modern IQ tests, the raw score is transformed to a normal distribution with mean 100 and standard deviation 15. abilities give different answers to specific questions on the same IQ test.
