Race (human categorization) Skeletal analysis Race is a categorization of humans based on shared physical or social qualities into groups generally viewed as distinct within a given society. While partly based on physical similarities within groups, race does not have an inherent physical or biological meaning. determine the expected answer. Modern science regards race as a social construct, an identity which is assigned based on rules made by society. The term came into common usage during the 16th century, when it was used to refer to groups of various kinds, including those characterized by close kinship relations. They should also be aware of the biological inaccuracies contained in that "politically correct" answer. The concept of race is foundational to racism, the belief that humans can be divided based on the superiority of one race over another.
