Scientific method But as tends to be The scientific method is an empirical method for acquiring knowledge that has been referred to while doing science since at least the 17th century. Scientific inquiry includes creating a testable hypothesis through inductive reasoning, testing it through experiments and statistical analysis, and adjusting or discarding the hypothesis based on the results. Historically, it was developed through the centuries from the ancient and medieval world. Mixed methods research is more specific in that it includes the mixing of qualitative and quantitative data, methods, methodologies, and/or paradigms in a research study or set of related studies. multimethod research includes the use of more than one method of data collection or research in a research study or set of related studies.
