Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education In May, over 5,000 students took the HKDSE History exam. The HKDSE examination is Hong Kong's university entrance examination, administered at the completion of the three-year New Senior Secondary (NSS) education, allowing students to gain admissions to undergraduate courses at local universities through JUPAS. Students normally begin studying the syllabus at the beginning of Year 10 and take the test at the end of Year 11. However, in some international schools, students can begin studying the syllabus at the beginning of Year 9 and take the test at the end of Year 10. Certificate of Secondary Education CSE examinations were held in the years 1965 to 1987. GCE and CSE exam boards experimented with offering a combined O-Level and CSE examination, in the 1970s, for borderline candidates. Also, in some African and former British colonial countries (such as, Kenya) there is a qualification named the Certificate of Secondary Education based on the original and former British variant. This qualification should not be confused with the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education which is a school-leaving qualification in India. Also, the CSE should not be confused with the African qualification CSEE (Certificate of Secondary Education Examination).
