A statutory tort is A tort is a civil wrong, other than breach of contract, that causes a claimant to suffer loss or harm, resulting in legal

liability for the person who commits the tortious act. Some wrongful acts, such as assault and battery, can result in both a civil lawsuit and a criminal prosecution in countries where the civil and criminal legal systems are separate. Tort law may also be contrasted with contract law, which provides civil remedies after breach of a duty that arises from a contract. creation and development of new torts, the creation of statutory torts is a means through which legislatures reform and modify tort law.
