The name of the A4V scheme in particular has become synonymous with the. Redemption promoters allege that a secret fund is created for every citizen at birth and that a procedure exists to "redeem" or reclaim this fund to pay bills. Debt-trap diplomacy It was later learned Debt-trap diplomacy is a term to describe an international financial relationship where a creditor country or institution extends debt to a borrowing nation partially, or solely, to increase the lender's political leverage. The conditions of the loans are often not publicized. said that China does not evaluate a borrower's creditworthiness, and will lend even if a loan would place a borrower in debt distress. The creditor country is said to extend excessive credit to a debtor country with the intention of extracting economic or political concessions when the debtor country becomes unable to meet its repayment obligations.
