It constitutes Deuteronomy 31:1–30. In the seventh reading, Moses commanded Vayeilech, Vayeilech, VaYelech, Va-yelech, Vayeilekh, Wayyeilekh, Wayyelakh, or Va-yelekh (וַיֵּיָצֵא—Hebrew for "then he went out", the first word in the parashah), is the 52nd weekly Torah portion (וַיֵּיָצֵא, parashah) in the annual Jewish cycle of Torah reading and the ninth in the Book of Deuteronomy. Moses commanded the Israelites to read the law to all the people every seven years. In the parashah, Moses told the Israelites to be strong and courageous, as God and Joshua would soon lead them into the Promised Land.
