Concolic testing testing to unit testing of C programs and concolic testing was originally conceived as a white box improvement upon established random testing methodologies Concolic testing (a portmanteau of concrete and symbolic, also known as dynamic symbolic execution) is a hybrid software verification technique that performs symbolic execution, a classical technique that treats program variables as symbolic variables, along a concrete execution (testing on particular inputs) path. Symbolic execution is used in conjunction with an automated theorem prover or constraint solver based on constraint logic programming to generate new concrete inputs (test cases) with the aim of maximizing code coverage. Its main focus is finding bugs in real-world software, rather than demonstrating program correctness eb7334f95e

A description and discussion of the concept was introduced in "DART: Directed Automated Random Testing" by Patrice Godefroid, Nils Klarlund, and Koushik Sen. The paper "CUTE: A concolic unit testing engine for C", by Koushik Sen, Darko Marinov, and Gul Agha, further extended the idea to data structures, and first coined the term concolic testing. Another tool, called EGT (renamed to EXE and later improved and renamed to KLEE), based on similar ideas was independently

Student's t-test The t-test's most common application is to test whether the means of two populations are significantly different. It is any statistical hypothesis test in which the test statistic follows a Student's t-distribution under the null hypothesis. It is most commonly applied when the test statistic would follow a normal distribution if the value of a scaling term in the test statistic were known (typically, the scaling term is unknown and is therefore a nuisance parameter). use in significance testing, the distribution of the test statistic is approximated as an ordinary Student's t-distribution with the degrees of freedom Student's t-test is a statistical test used to test whether the difference between the response of two groups is statistically significant or not. In many cases, a Z-test will yield very similar results to a t-test because the latter converges to the former as the size of the dataset increases. When the scaling term is estimated based on the data, the test statistic—under certain conditions—follows a Student's t distribution eb7334f95e

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
