Tree models where the target variable can take a discrete set of values are called classification trees; in these tree structures, leaves represent class labels and branches represent conjunctions of features that lead to those class labels. Decision trees where the target variable can take continuous values (typically real numbers) are called regression trees. More generally, the concept of regression tree can be extended to any kind of object equipped with pairwise dissimilarities such as categorical sequences.

Textual criticism This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. many approaches or methods to the practice of textual criticism, notably eclecticism, stemmatics, and copy-text editing. Intentional alterations may have been made as well, for example, the censoring of printed work for political, religious or cultural. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant. Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work
