Snorkel (swimming) Meanwhile, in 1957, the US monthly product-testing magazine Consumer Reports concludes A snorkel is a device used for breathing atmospheric air when the wearer's head is face downwards in the surface water with the mouth and the nose submerged. A standard snorkel is a curved tube with a shape usually resembling the letter "L" or "J", fitted with a mouthpiece at the lower end and made from plastic, synthetic elastomers, rubber, or light metal. It may be either a separate unit, or integrated into a swimming or diving mask. The snorkel may have a loop or a clip to attach it to. Ian Thorpe Due to his unhappy experiences Ian James Thorpe (born 13 October 1982) is an Australian retired swimmer who specialised in freestyle, but also competed in backstroke and the individual medley. He has won five Olympic gold medals, the second most won by any Australian after fellow swimmer Emma McKeon. With three gold and two silver medals, Thorpe was the most successful athlete at the 2000 Summer Olympics, held in his hometown of Sydney. was advised to take up swimming to strengthen a broken wrist, so by chance, the five-year-old Thorpe followed her into the pool d88cecbec2

At the age of 14, Thorpe became the youngest male ever to represent Australia, and his victory in the 400 metre freestyle at the 1998 Perth World Championships made him the youngest-ever individual male World Champion. After that victory, Thorpe dominated the 400 m freestyle, winning the event at every Olympic, World, Commonwealth and Pan Pacific Swimming Championships until his break after... d88cecbec2

Michael Phelps Four years later, when he won eight gold medals at the 2008 Beijing Games, he broke fellow American swimmer Mark Spitz's 1972 record of seven first-place finishes at any single Olympic Games. races in three different strokes at a national championship. He is the most successful and most decorated Olympian of all time with a total of 28 medals. At the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens, Phelps tied the record of eight medals of any color at a single Games, held by gymnast Alexander Dityatin, by winning six gold and two bronze medals. Phelps also holds the all-time records for Olympic gold medals (23), Olympic gold medals in individual events (13), and Olympic medals in individual events (16). At the 2012 Summer Olympics in London, Phelps won four gold and two silver medals.
