Medieval antiphonaries varied with regional liturgical tradition. In 1570, following the Council of Trent, the Roman Rite antiphonary was declared universal. The Roman Antiphonary (*Antiphonale Romanum*) contains the chants for the canonical hours for the hours of Lauds, Prime, Terce, Sext, None, Vespers and Compline for every day of the year. The *Vesperale Romanum* is an excerpt of the Antiphonary containing the chants sung at Vespers.
