Originally named the Whitbread Book Awards from 1971 to 2005 after its first

sponsor, the Whitbread company, then a brewery and owner of pub-restaurant chains, it was renamed when Costa Coffee, then a subsidiary of Whitbread, took over sponsorship. The companion Costa Short Story Award was established in 2012. The awards were discontinued in 2022. Costa Coffee was purchased by the Coca-Cola Company in 2018 30fd0619a2
