As a teacher examines a student's solution process, In science education, a word problem is a mathematical exercise (such as in a textbook, worksheet, or exam) where significant background information on the problem is presented in ordinary language rather than in mathematical notation. As most word problems involve a narrative of some sort, they are sometimes referred to as story problems and may vary in the amount of technical language used

Caleb Gattegno The class becomes a kind of guided improvisation in which the teacher launches a challenge at a suitable level for the students Caleb Gattegno (1911-1988) was an educator, psychologist, and mathematician. He is best known for introducing new approaches to teaching and learning mathematics (Visible & Tangible Math), foreign languages (The Silent Way) and reading (Words in Color). wherever they need it to go. Gattegno also developed pedagogical materials for each of these approaches, and was the author of more than 120 books and hundreds of articles largely on the topics of education and human development. He is considered one of the most influential and prolific mathematics educators of the twentieth century

Discovery learning It is also referred to as problem-based learning, experiential learning and 21st century learning. their experiences Classroom culture where there is a shared sense of purpose between teacher and students, where open-mindedness and dialogue are encouraged Discovery learning is a technique of inquiry-based learning and is considered a constructivist based approach to education. It is supported by the work of learning theorists and psychologists Jean Piaget, Jerome Bruner, and Seymour Papert 84ab574ebd

Jerome Bruner is often credited with originating discovery learning in the 1960s, but his ideas are very similar to those of earlier writers such as John Dewey. Bruner argues that "Practice in discovering for oneself teaches one to acquire information in a way that makes that information more readily viable in problem solving". This philosophy later became the discovery learning movement of the 1960s.
