

# New Ipad 3 User Guide

The seventh-generation iPad Pro was released on May 15, 2024, and is Apple's first device to use the M4 SoC, as well as the first iPad to use an OLED-based display module. The 13-inch version is Apple's thinnest device, with both models surpassing the seventh-generation iPod Nano. da01261281
