Trigonometry The Greeks focused on the calculation of chords, while mathematicians in India created the earliest-known tables of values for trigonometric ratios (also called trigonometric functions) such as sine. The field emerged in the Hellenistic world during the 3rd century BC from applications of geometry to astronomical studies. In particular, the trigonometric functions relate the angles of a right triangle with ratios of its side lengths. similar triangles and discovered some properties of these ratios but did not turn that into a systematic method for finding sides and angles of triangles. For the complex number $2 + 3i$ The segments of a closed polygonal chain are called its edges or sides. The points where two edges meet are the polygon's vertices or corners. An n -gon is a polygon with n sides; for example, a triangle is a 3-gon.

Square The area of a square is the side length multiplied by itself, and so in algebra, multiplying a number by itself is called squaring.

Squares are special cases of rectangles, which have four equal angles, and of rhombuses, which have four equal sides. As with all rectangles, a square's angles are right angles (90 degrees, or $\pi/2$ radians), making adjacent sides perpendicular. permute the eight isosceles triangles between the half-edges and the square's center (which stays in place); any of these triangles can be taken as the fundamental In geometry, a square is a regular quadrilateral.
