She was sensitive to the openings and endings of her books, and insisted *Benjamin Bunny* finish with the words "rabbit-tobacco", a term she appropriated from the *Uncle Remus* stories by Joel Chandler Harris, one of her literary heroes. 299daf343f The *Tales of Beatrix Potter* is the only feature film directed by Mills, who is best remembered as a film editor.
