They reached Greece, where they were nearly trapped by the German invasion in 1941, but escaped to Egypt, where they parted. She then worked for the British government, running a library in Cairo. Firstly, as a surgeon at the Glasgow Royal Infirmary, he introduced carbolic acid (modern-day phenol) as a steriliser for surgical instruments, patients' skins, sutures, surgeons' hands, and wards, promoting the principle of antiseptics. Secondly, he researched the role of inflammation and tissue perfusion in the healing of wounds. Thirdly, he advanced diagnostic science by analysing specimens using microscopes. Fourthly, he devised strategies to increase the chances of survival after surgery. Tycho Brahe contraptions such as his large quadrant and sextant were "useless and even harmful". He was known during his lifetime as an astronomer, astrologer, and alchemist. He was the last major astronomer before the invention of the telescope and has been described as the greatest pre-telescopic astronomer. From 1597 to 1598, he spent a year at the castle of his friend Heinrich Tycho Brahe (TY-koh BRAH(-h)ee, - BRAH(-hə); Danish: ['tsʰykʰo 'pɒːə] ; born Tyge Ottesen Brahe, Danish: ['tsʰyːjə 'lʌsən 'pɒːə]; 14 December 1546 – 24 October 1601), generally called Tycho for short, was a Danish astronomer known for his comprehensive and unprecedentedly accurate astronomical observations which helped to turn astronomy into the first modern science and launch the Scientific Revolution 769376e7bb
