Antibody For example An antibody (Ab), or immunoglobulin (Ig), is a large, Y-shaped protein belonging to the immunoglobulin superfamily which is used by the immune system to identify and neutralize antigens such as bacteria and viruses, including those that cause disease. Antigen literally means "antibody generator", as it is the presence of an antigen that drives the formation of an antigen-specific antibody. Detection of particular antibodies is a very common

form of medical diagnostics, and applications such as serology depend on these methods. Each of the branching chains comprising the "Y" of an antibody contains a paratope that specifically binds to one particular epitope on an antigen, allowing the two molecules to bind together with precision. Using this mechanism, antibodies can effectively "tag. Each individual antibody recognizes one or more specific antigens, and antigens of virtually any size and chemical composition can be recognized e95cfd196f

Candida albicans is the most commonly implicated organism in this condition. *C. albicans* is carried in the mouths of about 50% of the world's population as a normal component of the oral microbiota. This candidal carriage state is not considered a disease, but when *Candida* species become pathogenic and invade host tissues, oral candidiasis can occur. Droplet-based microfluidics Interest in droplet-based microfluidics systems has been growing substantially in past decades. Microdroplets offer the feasibility of handling miniature volumes (μL to fL) of fluids conveniently, provide better mixing, encapsulation, sorting, sensing and are suitable for high throughput experiments. Two immiscible phases used for the droplet based systems are referred to as the continuous phase (medium in which droplets flow) and dispersed phase (the droplet phase), resulting in either water-in-oil (W/O) or oil-in-water (O/W) emulsion droplets. For some applications, Raman spectroscopy is preferred over other detection methods such as infrared (IR) spectroscopy

Droplet-based microfluidics manipulate discrete volumes of fluids in immiscible phases with low Reynolds number (< 2300) and laminar flow regimes. many qualitative biological applications e95cfd196f
