The Senate's origins trace back to the 1787 Constitutional Convention, where James Madison's Virginia Plan proposed a bicameral national legislature. The structure was ultimately shaped by the contentious Connecticut Compromise—a narrow 5–4 vote, which granted smaller states disproportionate representation in the Senate.
