The intravenous form, fosphenytoin, is used for status epilepticus that does not improve with benzodiazepines. It may also be used for certain heart arrhythmias or neuropathic pain. Severe low blood pressure and abnormal heart rhythms can be seen with rapid infusion of IV phenytoin. Blood levels can be measured to determine the proper dose. It is useful for the

prevention of tonic-clonic seizures (also known as grand mal seizures) and focal seizures, but not absence seizures. It can be taken intravenously or by mouth 9ae8b9d030

Opioid epidemic in the United States The first wave of the epidemic in the United States began in the late 1990s, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), when opioids were increasingly prescribed for pain management, resulting in a rise in overall opioid use throughout subsequent years. The opioid epidemic unfolded in three waves. The second wave was from an expansion in the heroin market to supply already addicted people. The third wave, starting in 2013, was marked by a steep tenfold increase in the synthetic opioid-involved death rate as synthetic. the start of the epidemic, began in the 1990s due to the push towards using opioid medications for chronic pain management and the increased promotion There is an ongoing opioid epidemic (also known as the opioid crisis) in the United States, originating out of both medical prescriptions and illegal sources. This allows the medication to be absorbed more rapidly and avoid the first pass effect. An injection is considered a form of parenteral drug administration; it
