Western Electric was an American electrical engineering and manufacturing company that operated from 1869 to 1996. the same location under Western Electric operations until sold in 1925 to ITT. A subsidiary of the AT&T Corporation for most of its lifespan, Western Electric was the primary manufacturer, supplier, and purchasing agent for all telephone equipment for the Bell System from 1881 until 1984, when the Bell System was dismantled. , Inc. Because the Bell System had a near-total monopoly over telephone service in the United States for much of the 20th century, Western Electric's equipment was widespread across the country.
